The Nottingham Mild Trail and The Vale of Belvoir Trail

This year your Mild in May supplement contains two trails. There is the Nottingham Trail with 31 pubs all situated within easy reach of the city centre. There is also the Vale of Belvoir Trail with 15 pubs all within the Vale area.

If you've never tried Mild, now is your chance to appreciate the wide variety of Milds available and also try a few pubs you may not have been to before.

Every May CAMRA promotes mild and there is a National Mild Day on Saturday 10th May.

There is an impressive range of Light and Dark Milds to be savoured, produced by breweries from all over the country. There are several milds brewed locally including the recently renamed Hardys & Hansons Kimberley Mild. Nottingham Rock Mild is being distributed to over 25 pubs in the area during May and is also reaching further afield. Castle Rock Black Gold is to be found throughout the Tynemill Estate and in other outlets. Other local micro breweries also produce Milds and these will be found around the region during May. See how many different ones you can find.

Over 100 people completed the Nottingham trail last year, the most successful to date.

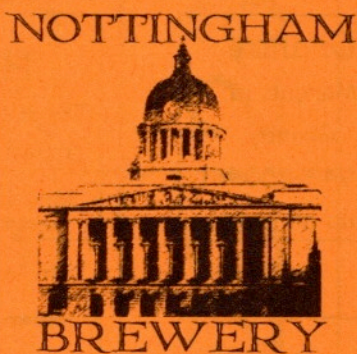
Victoria Leisure Centre, Sneinton Market from Thursday 16th October to Sunday 19th October.

HOW TO DO IT**

1. Order a pint or half pint of **Cask Mild** in one of the participating pubs and ask for a Mild Sticker.
2. Be patient if the pub is busy.
3. Put the sticker on the appropriately numbered square on your Mild Trail form.
4. Collect stickers from any 8 different pubs to qualify for the Bronze Certificate.
5. Collect stickers from any 16 different pubs to qualify for the Silver Certificate.
6. Gold Certificates are awarded to those nutters mad enough to do all 31 pubs!
7. Send in your form with 8 or more stickers to:

At the end of the month send your card by 14th June 2003 to Mr. E. Fendell, 5 Nottingham Road, Cropwell Bishop, Notts NG12 3BP. Completion certificates will be awarded as follows:-

- 15 pubs validated on sheet - Gold
- 12 pubs validated on sheet - Silver
- 10 pubs validated on sheet - Bronze

Whilst Landlords have tried to be as accurate as possible with dates given, if you are making a long or special journey to one of the pubs listed it is advisable to phone first to check on availability to avoid disappointment. If cask mild is not available at the listed pub during the dates given you are still able to have your card validated.
